Pre-Course Practices at home.

- Reward Selection.
- Using a Long-Line.
- Reflex to name.
- Eye contact.
- Conditioning Recall Cues.

Don't forget to bring:

- Your lead and long-line training lead. (we have some for you to borrow).
- Lots and lots, of your dog's favourite rewards.
- Drinks for you, there is a water supply for the dogs.
- A water bowl for your dog.
- A pair of gloves for safe use of the long line.
- A well fitted harness for your dog.
- Poo bags (we have spares if forgotten).

The Training Location.


- With their kind permission we are using the **All About the Dog Training Academy**.
